

Aalam Bibi Trust is an independent, non-profit, non-political charitable organization, working to uplift the living standards of the less-privileged segments of the population by addressing basic needs of life, irrespective of their sex, caste, creed, race or religion. With its innovative educational model and integrated community development projects, Aalam Bibi is helping the underdeveloped population of Chungi Amar Sidhu, Kot Lakhpat, Lahore, and in Muridke, district Gujranwala to have access to their basic rights to literacy, food, healthcare and a better future and a healthy present for the youth.

Aalam Bibi functions are performed by an innovative model, which is based on the holistic development approaches for the community focus on quality rather than quantity.



With a humble beginning of 60 students in the first session, Aalam Bibi School currently has 1040 students pursuing their studies, including students with different abilities and students studying higher levels of education outside Aalam Bibi campuses.


Background

An 18-year old undergraduate student and an aspiring writer, Farah Deeba Akram, used to pen down the lifestyle of people belonging to different strata of the society. One day while walking in the slums and jotting down her observations about life outside the posh areas of Lahore, she gave biscuits to the street children who were constantly looking at her bag. "I don't need the biscuits", said one of the street children. "I wish to have a pencil and a copy from your bag". Farah was greatly moved by the quest for formal education shown by the street children and decided to provide them their basic right to education.

Hence, under the shadow of a tree, the Aalam Bibi School had its humble beginning in 2005 when Farah made a routine to go every day in the sub-urban industrial area of Kot Lakhpat – then notorious for drug addicts and street criminals. Meanwhile, she rented a small house of almost 4-marla (80 sq. meters) in the same locality and converted that into a school building. She started a door- to-door campaign for the importance of education and enrolled 60 students in the first batch. Initially, the school was run solely by her pocket money and funds donated by her father, a saving that he had reserved for the toll of her *Umra* offering. Farah was the only teacher and the administrator of the school. Soon, her family and friends joined her in the cause of Aalam Bibi and started volunteering at the school.

In 2008, the renowned columnist and philanthropist Munnu Bhai visited the school and wrote a column "*Nikki Jaei Kurri*". Hereafter, the utmost dedicated, selfless humanitarian work of the young and determined Farah got nationwide attention. Many generous donors joined this social cause. Currently, in 2022, more than 1000 students are studying from the playgroup to the university level with the support of Aalam Bibi.

Education has positively changed the lives of children and their families and has already uplifted the community.



The students are having their school books, stationery, uniforms, study tours, character-building workshops, medical facilities, extracurricular activities and mother/parents awareness sessions all free of cost.

The organization is fighting hunger by running a food program which distributes hygienic meals to the community and packs of monthly groceries to families whose income is insufficient to fulfil their daily nutritional needs.

Aalam Bibi is also running a project with a special focus on the health of the school kids and the community. A doctor pays regular visits to the community and the prescribed medicine is provided free of cost. Aalam Bibi also arranges free medical camps in the vicinity from time to time.

In 2022, Aalam Bibi reached the 17-year milestone of its philanthropic journey. In these years of dedicated work, the organization has grown in size and the scope of benefits for the community, against all odds. Each penny received from the generous donors and every altruistic deed by the volunteers helped the organization to develop better infrastucture, build a dynamic team and manage the vital supplies for its benefices.

With the immense support of donors, the community of the beneficiaries are thriving by raising their living standards and advancing towards a better future for the upcoming generations, in the presence of a reliable helping hand.

2.6. Ambassador of Aalam Bibi

Noor-ul-Hassan



Being a non-profit charitable organization, Aalam Bibi solely relies on donations from the public. In 2005, at the start of the journey, began with (350 USD) that were donated to the founder by her father and the school expenses kept on running from the savings of her pocket money and part-time job. Since then the organization largely relies on individual donors. In 2022, donations worth 59,605,000 PKR (2,29,312 USD) were raised by the administration. About 40% of the donations received are that of donations by regular monthly donors. All the donations so far have been raised from Pakistani individuals.

The organization has a qualified accounts staff member who keeps an audit of the organizational assets and expenditures. The income of the trust has an exemption from tax, as granted by Section 2(36) and Section 59 of the Income Tax Ordinance, 2001. The brief description of the funds and expenditures during the fiscal year 2020-202i is as follows, in Pakistani rupees:



4. FIGHTING IGNORANCE




Aalam Bibi's elucidation of quality education is formal education (Taleem) accompanied by character building (Tarbiyat), with an aim to nurture a future citizen from a tender child to an economically independent individual with civic & social responsibility, creative & critical thinking and emotional intelligence.

Aalam Bibi has an effective educational model which is a practical foundation of its entire educational enterprise. The main components of this model are secondary education, inclusive, and tertiary education programs in addition to its faculty development program and mother awareness programs which provide in-direct support to achieve its standards of quality education.



Aalam Bibi's unique educational model aims to nurture a child at all levels, from an artless youngster to a socially responsible, emotionally intelligent and economically independent adult.



Two levels of education at Aalam Bibi

Aalam Bibi urges to secure the future of the coming generation by practising its educational philosophy inside the dynamic environment of Aalam Bibi classrooms by skilled teachers and outside the Aalam Bibi campuses with the help of its experienced mentors and well-groomed alumni. Every alumnus at higher education institutions or at work acts as an ambassador of his/her first alma mater.

SALIENT FEATURES OF ABT EDUCATIONAL MODEL

- Emphasize on formal education along with social, moral and emotional development.

4.1 Aalam Bibi Taleem-o-Tarbiyat School

Currently, 1000 students are enrolled in Aalam Bibi Taleem-O-Tarbiyat School including its Main Campus, Chungi Amar Sindhu, Lahore and Murdikay Campus. Every Aalam Bibi student enjoys free education with uniforms, books, stationery, study tours, monthly grand lunch, medical facility, co-curricular activities, and student-led magazines. Around 150 selected students receive a free daily lunch. They also get Eid gifts and Qurbani meat on the occasions.

It was based on how to recycle, reuse and convert the waste in order to reduce and eliminate the adverse impact of waste on human health and the environment,





Global Warming

Excessive use of fossil fuel, deforestation, power plants, oil drilling, transport and vehicles and greenhouse emissions of gasses trap sunlight, thus causing global warming. The model was based on causes, effects and solutions for global warming.

Aalam Bibi Classrooms

Inside the Aalam Bibi Schools, the vernacular preferences are set in accordance with the children's shared backgrounds, and the curricular outlines are optimized by each child's unique needs, by which quality is obtained out of quantity.

Along with the keen perseverance of academic excellence, the values of kindness, love, and empathy are emphasized. The following are the main features of the Aalam Bibi classrooms.

- Knowledge building along with knowledge sharing: The teacher-student interaction is based on building knowledge rather than just sharing the existing knowledge in a crude and narrow frame. Root learning and cramming are not encouraged in the classroom.
- Activity-based learning: Team-work and group tasks are a vital part of activity-based learning that helps students to acquire social skills and emotional intelligence and builds an aptitude for cooperation rather than competition.
- Visually expressive lessons: The daily lessons are developed in a visually expressive manner, especially the lessons on science, history, and social studies are taught with the visual support of images and videos. Every classroom of Aalam Bibi on the main campus is equipped with a computer and LED to foster learning.
- Student-centred discussions: Discussion and Question & Answer session at the end of each lesson is compulsory. Students are trained and encouraged to share their ideas, teachers do not pass any judgment rather than the perspective of every student is critically reviewed and appreciated for its unique strengths. Aalam Bibi students are being trained to aim high and do not confine their dreams to their current socioeconomic status.










4.2 Inclusive Education Program

Alam Bibi Trust (ABT) believes that learning difficulties and disabilities should not be a barrier to any child. Thereby, Aalam Bibi established the Inclusive Education Program for differently-abled children in collaboration with Amin Maktab, the oldest organization in the city that is working for children with such demands.



Amin Muktab regularly trains teachers. A medical expert from Amin Maktab visits every month to Aalam Bibi and monitors the whole month's activities and performance of differently-abled students.

4.3. Parent Awareness Program

Aalambibi's goal to educate a child from the blossom of his cognizance is attained by taking care of a child when he still toddles by his cradle. Since its beginning, Aalambibi has been facing difficulties to convince mothers living in an under-developed community, that basic education is a fundamental right of every child and every child deserves to go to school. Overworked by the lowest-paid jobs, when they agree to send their child to school, the kids usually show signs of insufficient care and attention paid by their parents. Apart from the periodical PTMs (parent-teacher meetings), Aalam Bibi also arranges awareness sessions for the parents and especially for mothers. In these sessions, the mothers interact with the experts on the child's physical and mental wellbeing. Not only do the mothers of Aalam Bibi kids benefit from the sessions, but a common mother in the community can also participate and be a part of learning about a child's healthcare and grooming.

Parent Teacher Meeting

A parent teacher meeting was held. Students' academics and co-curricular matters were discussed at length (18th October 2022).







4.4. HIGHER EDUCATION PROGRAM

The majority of the Aalam Bibi Alumni are first-generation learners who completed secondary school certificates. Social gradients of educational inequalities are a bigger hurdle for them to lead the cabbler of higher education Therefore, Aalam Bibi provides the following facilities to them:



- Fees for universities and colleges
- Career and educational counselling
- Mentoring for their college and university admissions and scholarships
- Daily commute and travelling allowance
- Academic support during studies
- Regular workshops and certificate courses are being conducted to capacity building of students.

4.5. Food Program

Aalam Bibi Trust is serving in the area where the majority of people are living below the poverty line. They strive hard to fulfilling their basic needs but even then, unable to get the proper meals three times a day. Keeping in view the poor conditions of the labour class in the vicinity, Aalam Bibi is striving to provide quality, hygienic and healthier food to the labourers, hawkers, and other less privileged members of the community free of cost.

A food shop is operational in the locality which served 350+ meals every day. A large number of students attend school without breakfast because they belong to that underprivileged segment of society that is hardly able to take one meal a day. Aalam Bibi food program serves lunch to 150 students on campus and takes care of their nutritious needs. Under Aalam Bibi Food Programme, A grand lunch comprised of meat dishes is prepared for all the students in the school. Moreover, Rashan (monthly groceries) are distributed to the most vulnerable families in the community.









4.6. Healthcare Facilities

The community which Aalam Bibi is serving does not possess sufficient money to bear the expenses of quality healthcare. The majority of patients and attendants are daily wagers, Aalam Bibi Trust envisages providing a healthy standard of living to the marginalized group of society.



An eye camp was held in the school, 'Helping Hands'

Aalam Bibi started Munawar Shehzadi HealthCare Services in September 2012 intending to provide standard health facilities to students, their families, and the whole community of the area (Chungi Amar Sindhu & Kot Lakhpat) to resolve their most pressing health issues speedily and economically. Specialized doctor visits 6 days a week and the whole community benefits from this service by paying a token fee of Rs 10 only. The following facilities are provided to patients. Additionally, Doctor does the check-up of the students of Aalam Bibi School on a regular basis to improve the health of students which has a direct positive relation with the attendance and performance of students.

Along with providing medical facilities, Aalam Bibi has been promoting a healthy lifestyle in a society where health can be acquired without spending much by avoiding minor diseases, for example, washing hands properly can reduce the chances of diarrhoea. Patients are also responding positively and recognize the efforts of the organization. They take care of the resources of the medical centre by returning unused medicine, by regular follow visits for their checkup, and spreading awareness of a healthy lifestyle to other fellows

5. ABT PURPOSE-BUILT KNOWLEDGE PARK

After fighting illiteracy, poverty, and hunger for 17 years, now Aalam Bibi is at a crossroads towards something more significant – Constructing a state-of-the-art, purpose-built school campus equipped with the latest technologies.

5.1. Aalam Bibi Taleem-o-Tarbiyat School Campus

Since 2005, Aalam Bibi has been running its school(s) out of different rented properties – However, Aalam Bibi plans to construct a state-of-the-art, purpose-built campus, spanning over 12 kanals (65,340 sq. feet).

The campus will feature three major blocks:

Academic Block - to provide Taleem-o-Tarbiyat to students

Fine Arts Block - to provide learning opportunities for students having an artistic talent and an interest in arts and design

Vocational Training Block - to provide the basic foundational and hands-on education to students interested in learning technical skills - skills that breach the boundaries of implicit social norms.

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5.2. Community Academic Support Service

The unit will not only cater to the needs of Aalam Bibi students/alumni, but also those of the community – employing full-time student counsellors, who will guide our community members in matters like applying for university admissions, scholarships, and competitions (national and international). They will also provide information on job opportunities and help them prepare for the outside professional world.

5.3. Library, "a room of one's own"

The campus will feature a library with modern infrastructure, accessible to the community - a community where majority of families live in small (one-room) houses, which makes studying/reading difficult - Limited mobility makes it even more difficult for women to access spaces where they can learn/connect - Therefore, the library at Aalam Bibi will have a separate section where they can learn with some peace and quiet. The library will also provide them a space to socialise and network – empowering them to make use of their education for eradicating the status quo.
